Math- We learned to print numeral "eight" (#8) this week. Come up with story problems at home for the "family of 8." (1+7, 7+1, 2+6, 6+2, 4+4, 5+3, 3+5, 8+0, 0+8) Have your child write down "adding sentences." Practice counting by **2's** and **5's** to **30**.

Language Arts- Our letter this week was **Ww**. We learned how it looks, how it sounds it, and how to print it. We began an *AUTHOR'S STUDY* this week since it's **reading month**. Our first author is Ezra Jack Keats. We read many books by this author: *THE SNOWY DAY*, *GOGGLES*, *A LETTER TO AMY*, *PETER'S CHAIR* and *WHISTLE FOR WILLIE*. Many students gave their reports on rhinos and used the **Tux Paint** program on the computer to draw and write a sentence about something they learned about rhinos.

Science/Social Studies- We learned more about other animals and how fast they can run, etc. The kids experimented with toy cars and other objects to see which go "slower" and which go "faster" and used the terms: *PUSH* and *PULL*. We talked more about the 4 seasons.
